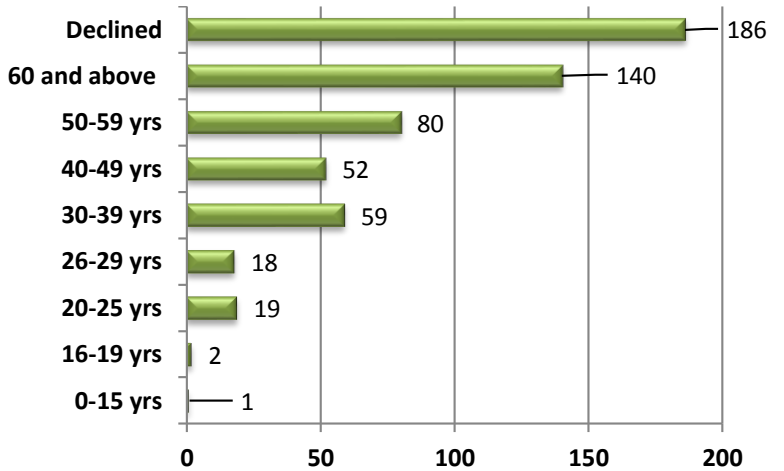

Who We Are Helping

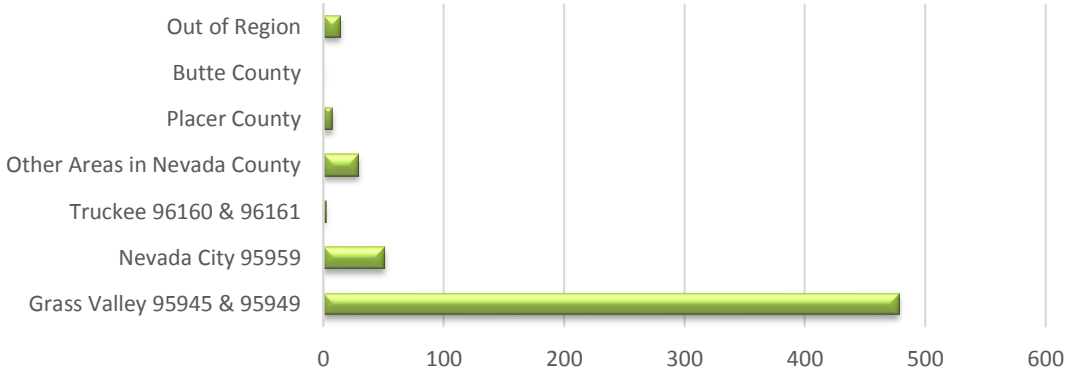

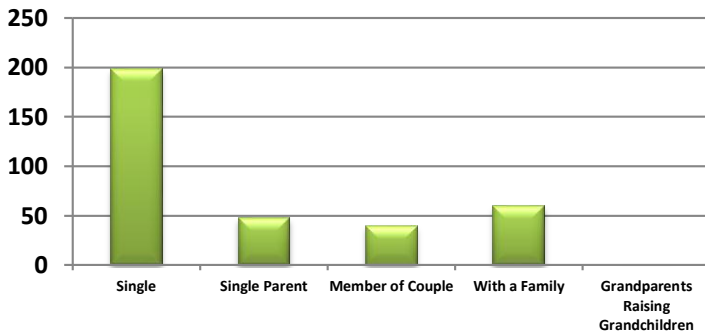
Partial breakdown of total callers
